LESSONS COVERED: Conversations, Social Communication, Handling Conflict, Likeability, Social Etiquette, Social Anxiety, Self-Identity & Body Awareness, Self-Motivation, Personal Issues, Unique Impact of ASD, Personal Hygiene, “Hanging Out,” Relating Rules, Friendly Dating, Serious Dating, Sexuality & Personal Responsibility, Boundaries, Risks & Dangers, Rejection & Forgiveness, Sensory Processing, Social Networking (just to name a few)
